TIPS TO MAKE YOUR EVENT BLOOM

Host a garden party to raise money for our brave lifesavers. To help you get started, here are some top tips on how to make the most of your event.

PLAN AHEAD

Whether you're throwing a big garden party for friends, firing up a relaxed barbecue for the family, or putting on some garden games for the kids (and big kids!) – make your garden party your own. Ahead of the big day, make it easy for guests to dig deep and support our volunteers by sharing your online fundraising page on social media. You'll find the link in the email you received when signing up.

RAISE FUNDS

RNLI lifesavers will drop everything to answer the call for help and save every one they can. Your friends and family can support you, and our volunteers, through your RNLI Garden Party by donating directly to your online fundraising page. You won't need to do a thing – the money will come straight through to the RNLI. If you receive any cash donations, you can bank them yourself and transfer the amount to your online fundraising page. Every contribution makes a real, lifesaving difference.

GROW YOUR DONATIONS

To help maximise the amount of money your garden party can raise, consider:

- Everyone likes tea, cake, and scones in the garden, so providing refreshments for a donation might help boost fundraising. Our cake toppers would look great on your fairy cakes!
- Tell your supporters a personal story about why you're raising money for the RNLI and how every penny they donate will help save lives at sea.
- Donate to your own online fundraising page to kickstart your total (the bigger the donation you're able to contribute helps encourage others to give big, too!).
- Upload a profile picture onto your online fundraising page – it will help your friends, family and work colleagues know they've come to the right place to support you.
